

PHP Password Hasher

The PHP Password Hasher generates secure password hashes for use in PHP login systems.

This tool is useful when:

- Adding users directly in phpMyAdmin.
 - Resetting passwords during development.
 - Testing login systems.
 - Verifying that a password matches a stored hash.
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Using the Hash in phpMyAdmin

Example:

```
INSERT INTO users (username, password)
VALUES (
    'admin',
    '$2y$10$z2QfYt0B0e9D9I5Yj7M4VuqhZgN3bU5QeK2Yl2sL5vLJ6m6r4Q9u0'
);
```

Remember

Passwords should **never** be stored as plain text in a database.

Always use:

```
password_hash()
```

to create passwords and

```
password_verify()
```

to check passwords during login.

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
